Summer Holiday Squash for All

We are running a summer holiday programme of coaching for members and non-members on Wednesdays up to and including Wednesday 31st August. Both group and 1-to-1 sessions are available. Places are still available for certain Wednesdays.





In addition, we are holding squash taster sessions at the Henley Leisure Centre on Tuesday 30th August for *children who are new to squash, or who have just started, or who have not played for a while*. An England Squash coach will provide expert tuition and the cost of a 90 minute session is £6. Separate sessions will be available for

different age groups If you are interested or have friends who might be interested then please let us know.

Remember, you don't have to be a member of Henley Junior Squash Club to come along to these summer squash sessions!

Squash Birthday Parties



Do you fancy a party with a difference? Then how about a squash party at Henley Leisure Centre over a Sunday lunchtime!!! Instead of the usual football or swimming party, why not have fun on the squash courts! Parties for up to 12 children of all abilities can be hosted for between 45 and 90 minutes. For the

younger children the focus would be on ball and racket skills, for the older children match play would also be introduced. A session on the squash courts could be followed by a relaxing swim! Costs would range from £20 to £60 depending on the number of children and the duration of the party.



Squash in the Olympics!

As part of the build-up to the 2012 Olympics, a programme of schoolbased events will be held in South Oxfordshire during 2011/12 under the title of the "South Oxon Schools Olympics". Squash has been included in the lists of events - there will be a squash tournament in January 2012 that the club will help organise.



The programme of events will start on **Friday 9th September** with fun runs around Marsh Meadows from 5 pm onwards. The various sports clubs in Henley can enter teams of four for different age categories and will be able to have a stall to promote their club. July's Fun Tournament

The latest in our series of fun tournaments was held on Sunday 17th July. 12 players entered with each one playing at least 6 matches during the afternoon with some real top squash being played. The top performance came from young Thomas Parr who ran his socks off against many of the older players and came out on top against some of them.

Training of Mini Squash Coaches

Are you 14 or over and interested in developing your squash coaching skills? There is an England Squash scheme for juniors to be trained as mini-squash coaches which involves attendance on a one day course at a local club. Ed Hughes-Burne and Bec Dixon have already attended such training courses and are now helping with junior coaching sessions (and being paid!!). If you are interested in putting yourself forward for training as a mini-squash coach, then the club will consider contributing to the cost of the course. If you are interested, then let us know.



Membership Renewal

A reminder that junior club membership is due for renewal at the beginning of September. The cost of membership is being kept at £18. Membership forms are available from the club's website (www.henleysquash.co.uk). Any player wishing to have after-school coaching, play in the junior leagues, play for the club and/or attend our amazing Christmas party (!!) needs to be a member. Furthermore, members have



the benefit of reduced fees for turn up & play and holiday squash sessions, plus automatic membership of England Squash and Racketball.

After-school Coaching for the Autumn Term

After-school coaching for members will start up on Wednesday 14th and Friday 16th September and run for a 12 week period to Wednesday 7th and Friday 9th December with a week off for half term (i.e., week beginning 24th October). Both



group and 1-to-1 sessions are available. Each session is 45 minutes and the total cost for the 12 sessions during the autumn term is:

- Year 6 & under group sessions: £72
- Year 7 & over group sessions: £84
- 1-to-1 sessions: £234 £270 (depending on the level of the coach)

If you are interested in these sessions, please let us know no later than **Wednesday 24th August**. In order to help us develop the coaching timetable, please let us know:

- the name(s) and age(s) of your child(ren);
- the day(s) and time(s) that your child(ren) can manage; and
- whether you are interested in group or 1-to-1 sessions.

Please note that those who received coaching during the summer term will need to re-register! If you don't, it will be assumed that you do not wish to continue.

Turn Up and Play

Turn up and play sessions will restart from **Sunday 11th September**. The focus of the sessions is to provide an informal environment in which the children can have fun playing one another at squash. The **Year 6 & under session is from 2.15 to 3.45 pm** and the **Year 7 & over session is from 3.45 to 5.15 pm**.

The sessions are open to members and non-members and will provide an



ideal environment for children new to squash to come and "have a go" (rackets and goggles will be provided for those who do not have them). The cost for each 90 minutes session is £3 for members (reduced to £2 if they bring a friend who is a non-member) and £4 for non-members (to be paid on the day).

Annual General Meeting

The Junior Club's AGM will be held on **Wednesday 21st September**. It will be an opportunity for us to share ideas and plans for the coming year on a range of activities including:

- coaching;
- junior leagues;
- friendly matches against other clubs;
- turn up and play sessions; and
- fun tournaments.

The meeting will be held at the Henley Leisure Centre and will start at 7.30 pm. All posts will be up for re-election so if you are keen to get involved with the running of the club, this is your opportunity!

After three years of sterling service, Shelley Djemil will be stepping down as **Treasurer** due to work commitments. The committee would like to take this opportunity to thank Shelley for all the hard work she has put in to ensure the smooth running of the Junior Club.

We also have a vacancy for a **Schools' Liaison Coordinator**. Their role would be to raise the profile of the Junior Squash Club within the local primary and secondary schools and to encourage the children to come along to our turn up and play sessions and give squash a go.
